BACHELOR OF QUANTITY SURVEYING (HONS)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants for Bachelor of Quantity Surveying (Hons) programme must obtain:

- Pass STPM with full pass in three (3) subjects and SPM / O-level three (3) credits including Mathematics; OR
- Pass A-level with full pass in two (2) subjects including Mathematics and English; OR
- Pass UEC with five (5) Grade B's including Mathematics and English; OR
- Pass Matriculation / Pre-U / Foundation from recognised institutions with minimum CGPA 2.50; OR
- Pass Diploma in related fields from recognised institutions with minimum CGPA 2.0; OR
- Other equivalent qualifications recognised by the Malaysian Government
- Diploma holders from BQSM approved institutions with CGPA 2.67 and above can apply for advance entry into year 2 of the degree programme subject to meeting the entry requirements of BQSM and UCTS.
